Rules & Regulations

Registration Deadline: September 27, 2010

- **Entry Fee is \$800.00 per two-player team.**
- **Tournament / Handicap Committee decisions are final.**
- **Company Eligibility:** Bona fide businesses are eligible—Federal Tax ID is required on Official Entry Form.
- **Subscription:**
 - Eligible company may enter two 2-man teams, any combination of NET & GROSS.
 - Under-subscription may result in cancellation of event and refund of entry & sponsorship fees.

Rules & Regulations, con't.

- **Player Eligibility (NOTE CHANGES)**
 - Amateur players only.
 - Players must be at least 21 years old.
 - Players must have proof of at least one-year employment with team company.
 - Players must have an established, valid and current USGA approved handicap index to enter NET DIVISION—All handicaps must be computed by the GHIN computation service. Non-handicapped players will be entered in GROSS DIVISION.
- **To Form a Team:**
 - Total maximum handicap index of NET DIVISION TEAM combined will be no more than 25.0. If total handicap is greater than 25.0, the player with the highest handicap index may play off a lower handicap to make the team eligible.
 - The handicap committee has the right to adjust handicap indexes before the competition if they determine posted scores are inconsistent for the season.
 - All players must have a minimum of 15 scores posted for this season.
 - Recent scores posted that are consistently higher than normal will be examined by the handicap committee and indexes may be adjusted.
 - The net division team must have a combination of no more than a 25.0 index and the difference between the 2 players can not be more than 10.0.
- **Tournament Entry & Withdrawals:**
 - Entry Fee includes use of range, golf cart, golf & awards banquet per player.
 - Entry Fees payable by check, M.O. or credit card.
 - Withdrawals/changes must be made on or before 9/27/10. Contact Tournament Manager.
 - Players submitted on Official Entry Form must be present.
 - Refunds subject to a 10% charge if made within 2 weeks of event.
